SHOOTING MATS ARE AVAILABLE FOR ALL 50M MATCHES

General Information

Entries:

Entries are required no later than **31st January 2012** and final squad numbers will be determined at that time. Receipt of entry will be emailed where possible.

Late Entries:

Will only be accepted if space permits within the limits of the number of squads determined after receipt of entries on **31st January 2012** and payment of late entry fee has been received.

Squadding Details, Equipment Check, Practice and Match Start Times:

These will be provided after the close of entries.

3P matches will commence 11am on the Saturday

Shooting Mats:

Range mats will be available for use for all Matches. Personal mats are able to be used provided they pass equipment check.

Juniors:

Juniors must be under 21 years on the **31st December 2012** to Qualify for the Junior Teams and events.

Juniors must enter the ISSF Junior Event to qualify for Junior Awards and teams.

(Junior Aggregate score for Junior Teams and Awards are from the Graded Matches and the Junior ISSF Match).

Juniors who elect to shoot in the Men's or Women's matches are not eligible for junior's teams or awards.

Your score on Thursday will count towards NZ Slazenger, and Inter Island teams or graded aggregate whether that be a Women's, Men's or Junior's match.

Veterans:

Veterans must be 60 years of age or over before the **21st February 2012** to Qualify for the Veterans award. The Veterans trophy is awarded to the highest Aggregate of the Graded Matches regardless of grade (Total score out of 1200)

North and South Island Teams and NZ Teams and Aggregate Trophies:

To be able to be selected for these Teams etc. you must compete in both the graded matches and an ISSF 50M match: (total score out of 1800)

The Top 20 aggregate scores will be selected for the NZ Slazenger Team + emergency

The Top 10 aggregate scores will be selected for the NZ Wakefield Team

The Top 3 Junior aggregate scores will be selected for the NZ Junior Team

The Top 3 Junior Men aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Men Drew Team

The Top 3 Junior Women aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Women Drew Team

The Top 10 Junior aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Drew Team

The Top 5 Women aggregate scores will be selected for the NZ Women's Team

The Top 22 aggregate scores from the NI will be selected for the NI Team

The Top 22 aggregate scores from the SI will be selected for the SI Team

The Top aggregate score from each grade will win the graded aggregate trophy

A, B, C & D graders please note that to qualify for the graded Aggregate trophy you must also enter for an ISSF match as well as the Graded Matches.
