Division 1: With two rounds to go before the Semi's the big guns are sorting themselves out. Manawatu have a firm grip on the top spot after an exceptional double header, taking maximum points off both Auckland and Waikato. The match against Waikato was no walkover though with only 1 point in the open and 2 points in the composite separating them. Canterbury are "Back" with a comfortable clean sweep over Eastern Force. Siggys is not happy, I think there will be a team talk. Hutt Valley and The Plainsmen shared the points but Bryan was gutted that they lost both the composite and the juniors by the narrowest of margins. The juniors had to go to countback to settle it. With Hutt Valley and The Plainsmen the two teams left with a double header there is nothing certain about the other three semifinal spots and as Eastern Force and the "A" Team face off in the last round there could be plenty of interest in the promotion relegation spot as well.

Division 2 pool A: This round had no effect on the overall standings. Taranaki and Alpine West shared the points and even though Otago had a good win over leaders Wellington it wasn't enough to keep them in Div 2 for the next round. In the redraw it will be Wellington and Alpine West in Div 2 with Otago and Taranaki in Div 3.
